



8. The application will question your parental responsibility. If you do not have parental responsibility you will need to ask the guardian that does to complete the application. If you have joint responsibility you will need to state that yourself and person you share responsibility with are happy for the application to go ahead. After selecting which applies to you, the system will ask you whether the child is looked after by the authority (child in care). Please answer Yes if this applies to you.
