

Hollinswood Primary School & Nursery – Breakfast Club Charging Policy

At our Breakfast club we believe in open communication with all our parents and staff. We set our charges in consultation with our parents and this pricing policy is presented to ensure that you fully understand our charging structure.

Sessions:

Monday to Friday term time only. From 7:45am to the start of the school day at 8:50am.

Payment:

- In receipt of free school meals: £1.40
- All other families: £1.80

Payment can be made on a daily, weekly or monthly basis.

Notice of any increase in fees:

Parents of children attending Breakfast club will be given half a term's notice of any increase in fees.

What is included in this price?

A healthy breakfast providing a choice of cereal and milk, fruit, toast and topping, fruit juice, milk or water. Special menus occur each term e.g. croissants. Bagels, yoghurt and dried fruit etc.

- The last breakfasts are served at 8.30am. After this time the club will provide a play environment only;
- Activities on offer include art and craft, computer, construction, brainwaves activities etc.

Registration:

A completed registration form must be completed prior to the first time your child attends the breakfast club. Attendance at the club is recorded on a register. As part of the registration process, as well as giving permission for your child to attend you are agreeing to take responsibility for them on their journey to school and up to the point they arrive at the breakfast club.

Illness:

Payment will not be taken if the session is booked and the child is ill. The payment will be carried forward to apply to the next session attended.

Discounts:

There are no discounts applied.

Places available:

There is no limit to the number of places available daily. All parents of pupils attending breakfast club, staff who run the club, staff and governors will be given a copy of the policy. It will also be included in the school prospectus.
