Value and monitor attendance and punctuality	Keep a register of attendance and punctuality each morning and afternoon (9.00 am and 1.00pm)	Attend regularly and punctually whenever possible. Come into school calmly and be in the classroom on time ready to start the day.	Ensure my child is in the classroom on time each morning. Attendance at school is a legal requirement.
Require that children are appropriately dressed for school activities. Encourage use of school uniform and provide parents with a copy of the school code of dress.	Encourage children to take care of their clothes and property.	Wear your uniform with pride; take care of your clothes and bring your PE kit when required.	Provide uniform and appropriate clothes for school activities. Make sure they are named.
Provide essential resources in a safe environment.	Provide the necessary materials for each lesson and ensure a safe working environment.	Take care of the school environment and equipment and look after books taken home.	Ensure that books and materials are returned to school. Encourage children to act safely.
Welcome you in school and offer you opportunities to become involved in the life of the school. Provide a broad and balanced curriculum with equal opportunities for all children. Provide opportunities to inform parents about the curriculum and teaching.	Prepare and deliver interesting lessons to achieve the objectives of the Early Years Foundation Stage and National Curriculum.	Do all your class work and homework as well as you can.	Take a positive interest in activities and work undertaken. Find out what is being taught and how you can help your child.
Provide a reading book to take home and homework as and when appropriate.	Set and monitor any homework as necessary.	Make time to read at home and complete any homework set.	Support your child with homework activities and reading at home. Find out what is being taught and how you can help your child.
Set appropriate targets and support special needs.	Cater for the differentiated needs of all pupils.	Try hard to improve your work. Tell your teacher or parent about any problems.	Talk with your school about any special needs or difficulties. Ask your child's teacher if you can help in any way.
Provide appropriate support.	Assess pupil's work regularly and liaise with parents when necessary.	Ask your teacher for help when you need it.	Attend parent/teacher meetings to discuss the progress and needs of your child.
Provide a quality environment with a wide range of facilities.	Create a stimulating ordered work environment.	Take care of the school and its equipment.	Offering help and encouragement in school.
Provide a clear framework of rules and values. Encourage your child to develop self-discipline through the school's policy of positive behaviour.	Explain clearly how pupils can improve their standards and make further progress. Encourage and promote appropriate behaviour.	Keep the school rules and code of conduct.	Support the school in upholding its rules and values.
Care for all pupils equally. Encourage parents to discuss any concerns.	Treat all pupils fairly and consistently.	Respect everyone you meet in school. Be kind and not hurt anyone in any way. Be helpful and friendly.	Encourage good inter- personal relationships and liaise with school if there are any difficulties
