Literacy

Bug club phonics

We will be learning:

- That our marks have meanings
- How to orally creating a story
- To listen to and perform rhymes
- How to write for a purpose
- How to apply our phonetic knowledge in our writing.
- About different punctuation/sentence structure
- How to segmenting/blend for reading and writing
- About words that rhyme



Maths—White Rose Maths

We will be learning to:

- Count to 20 and beyond
- Add and subtract
- Manipulate shapes
- Share and group
- Recognise odds, evens & doubles
- Create patterns and repeating patterns
- Make connections in our learning

Physical Development

We will be learning to:

- Use a balance bike to move around obstacles
- Pedal a bike
- Dribble a ball and keep control.
- Play a catching game with a partner.
- Take part in a race
- Hold a pencil with a secure pincer grip and form recognisable letters.



Expressive Arts

We will be learning about:

- Using mixed media to produce different artwork.
- Learning how to join different materials using different glues and tapes—talking about what weak and strong and structure mean.
- Learning what some structures are called i.e. houses/bridges
- Exploring mechanisms.
- Learning about the names of the different materials we are using.
- Being able to describe different textures.
- Looking at the illustrator Eric Carle.



Music

We will be learning about:

- Melody and rhythm.
- Different instruments.
- Different types of music genres.
- Performing songs solo or in a group

We will be learning about:

- What a family is—that we all have different responsibilities.
- Characteristics of healthy and safe friendships
- That everyone is different and we can be friends with anyone.
- Gender stereotypes
- Names and functions of parts of our body
- How to deal with our feelings

- What can we learn from stories?
- What makes places special?



Knowledge of the World -

Geography

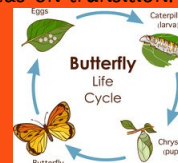
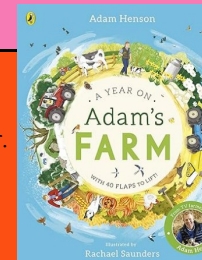
- Changes to the weather. Children to talk about how the seasons are changing and the weather is getting warmer.
- Learning about farms and their function in our community.
- Find out more about the town we live in
- Finding towns and farms on local maps.

History

- How have we changed? What did we look like in the past? Talk about what will happen next in the future—focus on transition.
- Farming and settlements in the past and present.

Science

- Hatching butterflies and chicks — observing life cycles
- Knowing the difference between a plant and an animal
- Growing plants from seeds and observing their growth over time.



Computing

We are learning:

- What a mouse/Mousepad is and what it does
- Click/drag and drop in a computer game
- Use mouse skills to compete a simple drawing
- What the keyboard does
- Use technological toys
- Use an ipad to take a photo or make a video
- Use a computer program to make music
