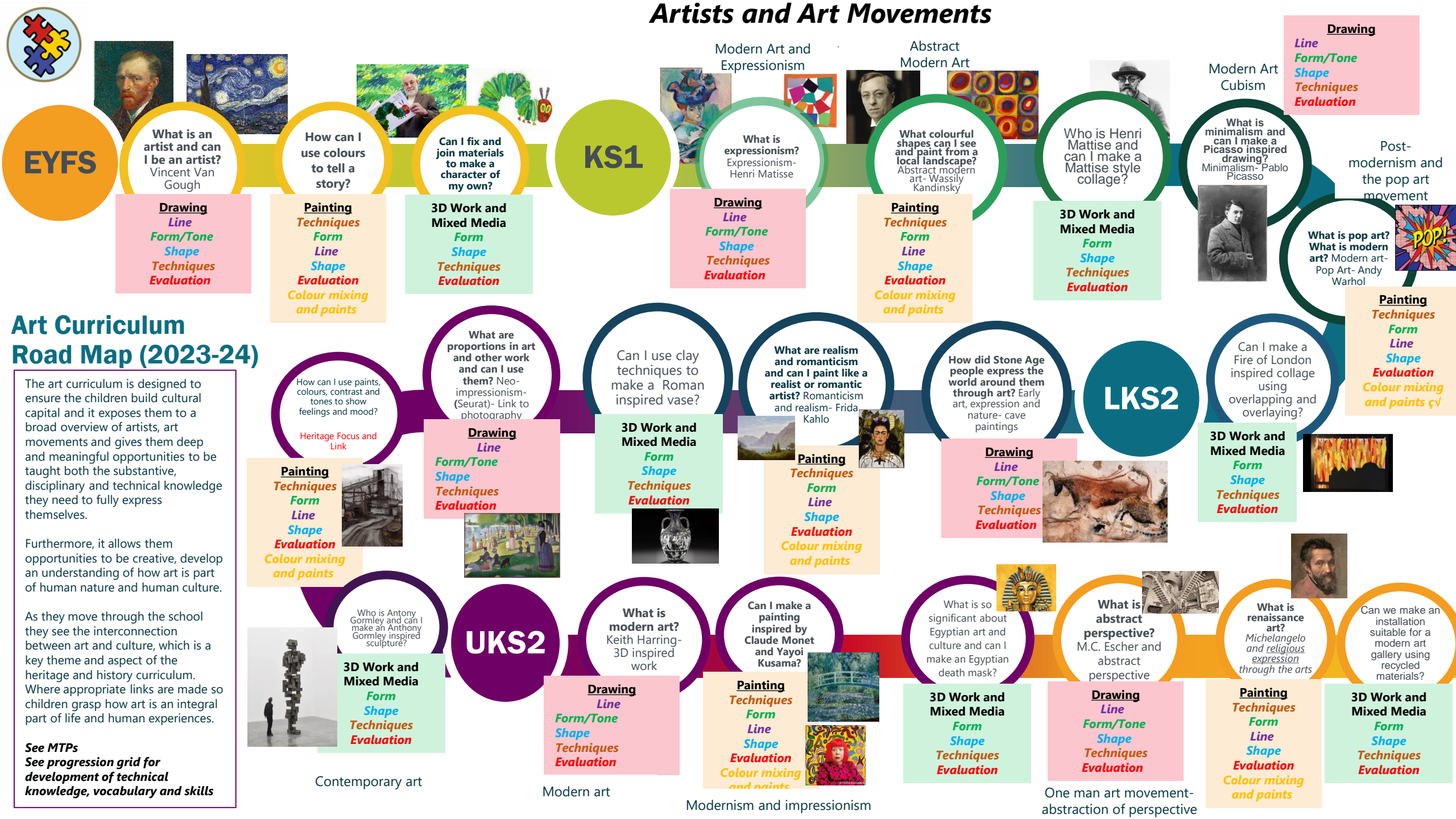

Art Curriculum Road Map (2023-24)

The art curriculum is designed to ensure the children build cultural capital and it exposes them to a broad overview of artists, art movements and gives them deep and meaningful opportunities to be taught both the substantive, disciplinary and technical knowledge they need to fully express themselves.

Furthermore, it allows them opportunities to be creative, develop an understanding of how art is part of human nature and human culture.

As they move through the school they see the interconnection between art and culture, which is a key theme and aspect of the heritage and history curriculum. Where appropriate links are made so children grasp how art is an integral part of life and human experiences.
